The aim of this workshop is to provide an understanding of genome editing, its strengths and problems, along with some examples of how it is being used.

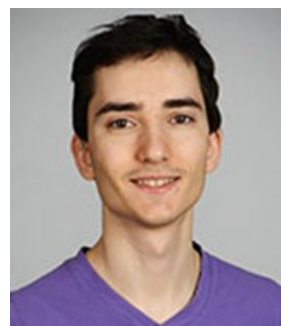
